


# WORKSHOP FOR **ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** CHILDREN AND GIRLS

#### PROPOSED ACTIVITIES:

1) Reading aloud of tales and fairy tales of the popular tradition of different countries of the world.

Proposed books are bi-lingual, Italian and in native language, in order to observe the different alphabets and the ways of writing.

Whenever possible, the passages are read in multiple languages, if the children are able to read the mother tongue.

2) Following the reading, reflection and sharing activities are proposed in groups and an artistic work to be done individually.

Encourage confrontation and dialogue between boys and girls

Observe similarities and diversity, valuing the importance of sharing and mutual respect

Books are always contained in the STORIES BAG, which accompanies us on this imaginary journey and acts as a guiding thread.


Before reading, the country we are talking about is identified on the PLANISPEHERE.





### LINGUISTICS MAP


Before starting, we gathered information on the languages that boys and girls speak with their family members at home.




